

When James McGill bequeathed his land in 1813 to found an institution of higher learning in Montreal, he set a precedent of transformative philanthropy. In the almost 200 years since McGill's establishment in 1821, numerous other visionary supporters have helped shape the University and the Faculty of Engineering. Both have always been collective ventures. There were setbacks along the way. In 1864 the Applied Science program was discontinued due to lack of funds. So in 1871, a group of philanthropists supported the creation of the new Faculty of Applied Science. Then, in 1889, the Faculty received its first home when gifts from Sir William C. Macdonald and Thomas Workman enabled the construction of the Macdonald Engineering Building. These early philanthropists knew that the fields of engineering and architecture would be essential to the industrial transformation of Montreal and Canada. Their partnership was central to the early success of the Faculty of Engineering. Fast forward to the current day, and these alliances have multiplied, helping build the Faculty into a world-class centre of teaching and research. This fruitful collaboration enables us to recruit top-notch researchers, empower a growing graduate studies programme, and, most importantly, provide a rich education for deserving students. En 1813, en cédant sa terre pour fonder un établissement d'enseignement supérieur à Montréal, James McGill a créé un précédent en matière de philanthropie transformatrice. Depuis près de 200 ans, c'est-à-dire depuis sa fondation en 1821, McGill a bénéficié du soutien de nombreux donateurs visionnaires qui ont contribué à façonner l'université et la Faculté de génie, deux projets qui ont toujours reçu un appui collectif. Mais le parcours a été semé d'embûches. En 1864, le programme de sciences appliquées a dû être suspendu par manque de fonds. Ensuite, en 1871, un groupe de philanthropes a favorisé la création de la nouvelle Faculté des sciences appliquées. Puis, en 1889, la Faculté a eu droit à sa première résidence grâce aux dons de Sir William C. Macdonald et de Thomas Workman, qui ont permis la construction du pavillon de génie Macdonald. Ces philanthropes des premiers jours savaient que les domaines du génie et de l'architecture seraient essentiels à la transformation industrielle de Montréal et du Canada. Leur partenariat a été un facteur clé dans les premières réussites de la Faculté de génie. Au fil des ans, les alliances se sont multipliées et ont contribué à faire de la Faculté le centre d'enseignement et de recherche mondialement réputé qu'il est devenu aujourd'hui. Cette collaboration fructueuse nous permet de recruter des chercheurs de talent et de nourrir un programme d'études supérieures en pleine croissance. Mais par-dessus tout, elle donne aux étudiants méritants la chance d'avoir une formation de choix.


