Master of Arts applicants - Please note that we only offer a Non-Thesis option for Gender and Women's Studies. Everyone else will apply to the Thesis program. You may choose to apply to an Option program as well, but this is not necessary, nor required.

Decisions will be posted on your account in SLATE as the decisions are made. This will typically be in mid-March for Ph.D. decisions and in April for M.A. decisions. If you do not see the decision in SLATE, this means a decision has not yet been made - check SLATE every few days from mid-March onwards.

If you are admitted into the program, you MUST officially accept or decline the offer in SLATE.

The deadlines to apply and submit your required documents are: December 15, 2023 for Ph.D. applications & January 15, 2024 for M.A. applications.

2. RESEARCH STATEMENT

Ph.D. To be uploaded with your online application. This is an academic statement, and it should discuss why you are interested in graduate study in Political Science, your research intentions, and agenda, and why McGill's program fits your needs. Focus on a project you want to pursue at the PhD level, refer to the questions you plan to research, the key concepts and political science literatures that you'd be drawing on
